Shipwire expands operations with UK facility

Shipwire has announced that it has expanded its operations in Europe by opening a new site in Britain.

Located in east Sussex, just outside London, the new facility provides expert storage and shipping for e-tailers, reducing shipping costs and times to Europe by as much as 75 per cent. Shipwire automatically connects with and adds order fulfilment and international shipping to a range of popular shopping cart and inventory management systems, including Yahoo!Stores, PayPal and Google Checkout.

Damon Schechter, Shipwire founder and CEO, stated: "Shipwire gives small businesses the storage and shipping infrastructure of a leading Fortune 500 business, helping them drastically reduce their shipping costs and times by leveraging the power of multiple warehouses."

Unveiling the new warehouse and pick/pack fulfilment facility, Shipwire claims that it provides usage-based plans starting from just \$29 a month for 16 cu ft of storage. The company now has locations in Los Angeles, Nevada Chicago, Toronto, Vancouver and London.
